Did you know that Arroyo Vista Elementary School was named a California Distinguished School in 2010, and the Gold Line has been running next to it for the last seven years? Adjacency to light rail affects neither student performance nor the willingness of parents to send their children to a great neighborhood school.

Did you know that currently the Overland signal at Ashby turns red 40 times per hour at peak periods, and the Expo Line will cross Overland only 24 times in that same hour? Coordinating the signals will mean minimal if any delays to north-south traffic.

Did you know that there is a Buddhist temple next to the at-grade Gold Line? Both priests and congregation report no complaints about noise or vibrations. If a temple, a place of meditation, can thrive next to a light rail line at grade, our neighborhood can too!

Did you know that what was once a vacant lot across from the Gold Line in South Pasadena now has a house being constructed on it? Adjacency to a light rail line is good for the neighborhood and increases property values!

Did you know that Expo has proposed two options for the Westwood Station, one with parking and one without, and that community input can have an impact on the decision between the two. We can work together for betterments that can be realized and that can make the Expo Line and the Westwood Station even greater assets for our community.
